Communication with owners and occupiers of adjacent facilities

In the event of a notifiable environmental incident occurring, owners or occupiers of premises in the vicinity of the licensed premises shall be advised and updated if they are likely to be affected. The method of communication with adjacent facilities and residents will depend on the risks posed by the incident as follows:

Nature of pollution incident	Mechanism for warning residents
Risk to health and safety of nearby residents appreciable	Door knocking, telephone and/or letterbox drops
Risk to health and safety of nearby residents not appreciable	Media release and Council website (where applicable)
